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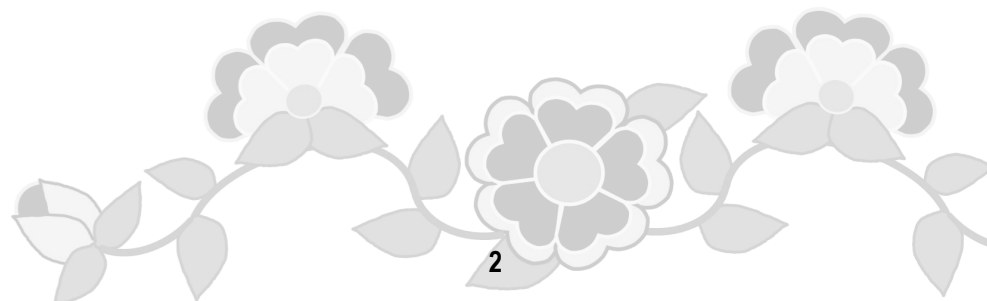
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Defining Positions

Aging & Disability Resource Specialist (ADRS) or (Tribal ADRS)

Tribes may contract with State directly or with ADRC in area for services. The ADRS will assist with making the decision

Serves: (Age 18 and over)

- Generalist who serves as a liaison and customer advocate to tribal members
- Provides basic information and assistance (referral), options counseling, and enrollment in publicly funded long term care services
- Ensures culturally appropriate information about aging and disability resources and can effectively access long term care programs and services
- Conducts information and assistance home visits for tribal members on behalf of the ADRC
- Assist tribal members in preparing materials needed to determine financial eligibility
- Some resources that are provided: housing, chore services, home modifications, adaptive equipment, transportation, health/nutrition/meal delivery programs, Medicare, Medicaid, and social security,...



Dementia Care Specialist (DCS) or Memory Care Coordinator

The Dementia Care Specialist work in conjunction with the EBS and ADRS to provide additional information and support for elders with dementia

Provide information and assistance to adults with memory or cognitive concerns or who have been diagnosed with dementia

- Memory Screens
- Specific activities and programs that connect people with social activities



- Provide support and information to family members and friends who are caregivers
 - Assistance with care planning
 - Support groups and respite
- Work with tribal agencies and local ADRC's to ensure programs and support for family and friends

Foster Grandparent & Senior Companion Tribal Elder Volunteer Program (FGP/SCP)

A program that recruits tribal elders to volunteer to support either other tribal elders or tribal youth

Volunteers get paid to volunteer 5-40 hours a week and are reimbursed for any travel they do during their volunteering

Must pass a background check and be 55 years or older

Senior Companion Volunteers assist other tribal elders by being a companion, taking them shopping or to medical appointments or just being a friend
Foster Grandparent Volunteers go into preschools, schools or after school programs to mentor and teach tribal youth about cultural traditions and practices to preserve the knowledge of the ancestors

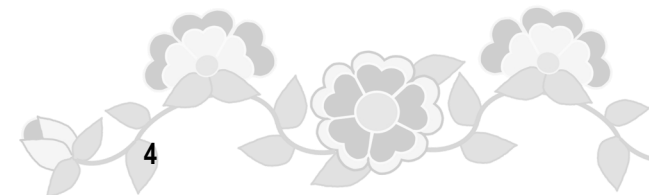
Medicaid Eligibility Outreach Specialist (MA or Eligibility Specialist)

Tribal Clinic or Health Center-based position

Funded through Wisconsin Medicaid Program (Contract administered by DHS Tribal Affairs)

Serves: (All clinic or health center clients)

- Identifying alternative resources for the Tribal clinic or health center to bill for services provided
- Assist Tribal clinic or health center to enroll public or private insurance programs they are or may be eligible



Senior Medicare Patrol (SMP)

Educations and empowers Medicare beneficiaries to be active participants in their health care through outreach, education, and one-on-one counseling.

Tribal Aging Units or Tribal Elder Programs

As funded by the Older Americans Act (Title III and Title VI)

Tribal Disability Benefit Specialist (DBS)

- Three GLITC Shared Service positions for all eleven Tribes in the State of Wisconsin
- GLITC funded by a direct service contract from the State of Wisconsin through the Aging Disability Resource Centers (ADRC) initiative part of Family Care
- Serves: Tribal members age 18 to 59
- Specialist who provides information and assistance with public and private benefit programs including application and appeal procedures for people with physical disabilities, developmental disabilities, mental illness, and substance abuse
- Legal backup services for this position is provided by the Indian Law Office of Wisconsin Judicare Legal Aide



Tribal Elder Benefit Specialist (EBS)

Aging unit-based program focused on serving Tribal Elders

Funded by the State, Federal Government, and Tribes and administered by the Area Agencies on Aging

Services are coordinated with Aging and Disability Resource Centers (ADRC)

Serves: Age 55 and over, except Ho-Chunk age 60 and over

- Generalist for providing benefits counseling, assistance, and advocacy for public benefits for Tribal Elders

Location of TBS

- GLITC provides one position that is a shared services position for six tribes (Bad River, Lac du Flambeau, Lac Courte Oreilles, Red Cliff, Sokaogon, St. Croix)



- Ho Chunk Nation
- Oneida
- Menominee Tribe and County

Legal backup services for this position are provided by the Indian Law Office of Wisconsin Judicare

Vocational Rehabilitation for Native Americans (VRNA)

Vocational Rehabilitation for Native Americans develops and delivers vocational support to eligible Native Americans/Alaskan Natives with disabilities living in the defined service area that are sensitive to their individual cultural beliefs, strengths, resources, priorities, concerns and abilities so each may engage in gainful employment.

Those eligible to participate in VRNA may receive support in the following ways:

- Vocational counseling
- Vocational evaluation and/or career exploration
- Job seeking skills
- Job development
- Transition from High school to post-secondary education or immediate employment
- Physical or technical aids needed to accommodate a disability in the workplace
- Tools and equipment
- Other Federally approved services needed to find, keep, or advance at a job.

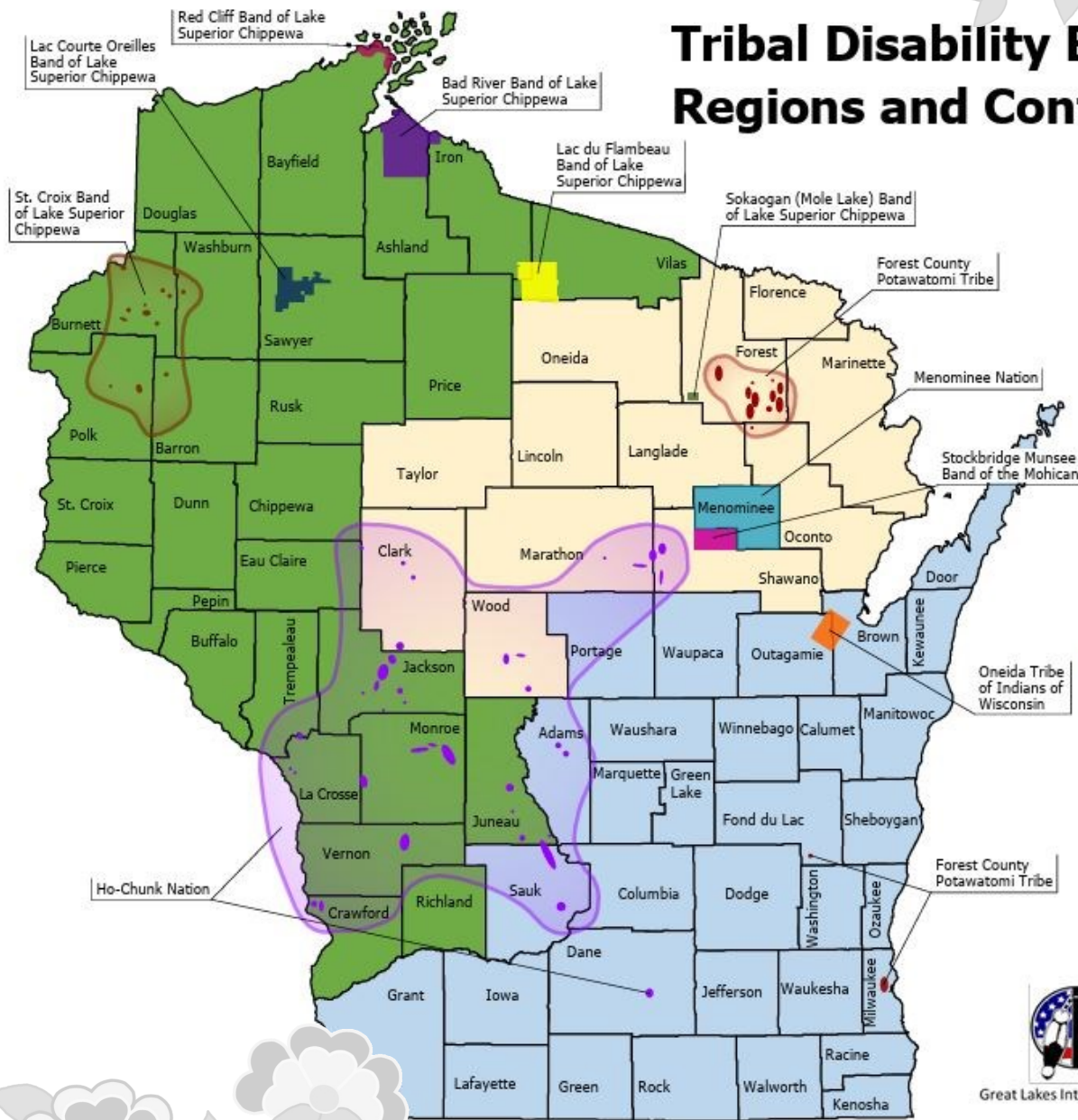
